

Official Rules for Harrison County Chamber Entrepreneur Contest “The Tank”

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN THIS CONTEST. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE OFFICIAL RULES. THE PRIZE WILL BE AWARDED SOLELY BASED ON A SKILL CONTEST.

AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES

Entry into The Tank (“Contest”) is available on the Harrison County Chamber (“The Host”) website, www.harrisoncountychamber.com (“Site”). Entry or participation in the Contest constitutes Entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules, and the decisions of the Host and its judges, which are final and binding. Entry, participation and/or winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. The Host of this Contest, Harrison County Chamber (“Host”) reserves the right to cancel this Contest for any reason that it deems appropriate, including, without limitation, a computer virus, bug or other technical problem or force majeure situation that corrupts the administration, security or proper functioning of this Contest. Should this Contest be canceled prior to the final date for entry, or any time during the Contest, notice will be posted on the Site or prior to the Contest.

ELIGIBILITY

This Contest is a competition involving substantial skill. This Contest is open only to (i) natural persons age 18 and older, and, (ii) Entrant represents and warrants that Entrant has the right, power and legal capacity to enter into the Contest, participate and perform all obligations hereunder. Further, the following apply: (iii) Business must be operated /located in Harrison County, West Virginia. (iv) Entrant cannot have been convicted of a felony. All Entrants are responsible for ensuring their submissions and participation in the Contest are in compliance with all legal requirements of their respective jurisdictions. (v) The business must have been established after 2021, and annual revenue must be less than one hundred thousand dollars. The Contest and prizes are subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations. The Contest and prizes are void where prohibited and otherwise restricted.

ENTRY

To enter, Entrants must complete and submit the online registration information or mail registration to Harrison County Chamber 520 West Main Street, Clarksburg WV 26301. Entrants must enter on an individual basis. No team Entrants will be allowed. No Entrant may enter more than once. The Host may disqualify any Entrant during or after the Contest period, if the Entrant (i) harms or publicly disparages the Host during or after the Contest period, (ii) the Host learns of the Entrants previous, current or future, immoral, illegal, or inappropriate acts, (iii) Entrant provides false information about, or publicly disparages, the Contest to the Host or to the public, or (iv) the Entrant does not obtain the Host's prior written approval before providing interviews or public comment related to the Contest. Entrants shall not use the trademarks of the Host or sponsoring companies, or falsely associate themselves with the Host or sponsoring companies, before, during or after the Contest period. You acknowledge and agree that you have no right to seek, and shall not seek, compensation from the Host or any of the Contest's sponsoring companies for any work related to the Contest.

Employees, directors and officers of the Sponsor, its advertising and promotion agencies, as well as the immediate family members and/or persons living in the same households of each, are not eligible for this contest. The contest is void where prohibited.

SELECTION OF APPLICANTS:

The host and application committee will select seven applicants on Thursday, December 1st 2022. Selection will be based on application, balance sheet, business plan, and profit and loss sheet if applicable.

Applicants will be notified on Monday, December 19th 2022 that they have been chosen as a contestant for The Tank Entrepreneur Contest.

Phase Two:

Workshops and Coaching Classes: The Host will provide workshops and coaching classes from January 2023 through March 2023 to prepare contestants for the event. Participation is not mandatory but recommended. Pre-recorded pitch will be filmed during this time.

Phase Three:

The Tank Entrepreneur Contest will be held Thursday, April 27th 2023 from 6pm-8pm at the Robinson Grand Theatre.

Awards and Grand Prize

There will be one grand prize winner that will receive a cash prize, thanks to the sponsors of The Tank.

Grand prize winner will also receive the benefits throughout the remainder of 2023 the following: membership with the chamber, mentorship from accountants, attorneys, insurance specialist, financial planners, financial institutions, human resource representatives, SBA representatives, etc. -at the sole discretion of the Host.

Fan Favorite

One Entrant will be selected as fan favorite the night of the event and a portion of ticket sales will be used as the fan favorite award.

Angel Investors

Angel Investors for all contestants may also be in the audience for opportunities to invest.

PRIVACY

By participating in the Contest, each Entrant authorizes the Host to collect, use, process, transfer and store all data and Innovation Plans provided by Entrant, including without limitation, personal data, to the United States, or any location(s) throughout the world that the Host deems necessary, whether within Entrant's country of residence or elsewhere, and with such party(ies) as the Host

deems appropriate, for purposes of administration of the Contest. All information submitted to the Host as part of this Contest will be treated in accordance with the generally accepted privacy standard statements. Personal information will be used only to: (a) provide information about the Contest; (b) contact and publicize the Contest, Entrants and potential winners; and/or (c) if an Entrant selects to receive additional information from the Host on the entry form, to send additional information to that Entrant during or after the Contest period. Entrants have the right to withdraw and correct their personal data, but Entrants are not allowed to re-submit new applications.

MISCELLANEOUS

The decisions of the Host are final with respect to all aspects of this Contest. In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, or other technical problem, or any condition caused by events beyond the reasonable control of the Host that may cause the Contest to be disrupted or corrupted, the Host may, in its sole discretion, either: (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Contest in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules; or (b) award the prize from among the eligible entries received up to the time of the impairment. The Host reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process, the operation of the Contest, to be acting in violation of these Official Rules, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such an attempt be made, the Host reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Host's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision. In the event an insufficient number of entries are received, the Host reserves the right to cancel the Contest and shall be under no obligation and at its sole and absolute discretion to award the prizes.

RELEASE AND LIMITATIONS ON LIABILITY

By participating in the Contest, Entrants agree to release, hold harmless, and fully defend/indemnify all directors, trustees, officers and employees of the Host, and its subsidiaries, affiliates, legal representatives, licensees, agents, advertising and Contest agencies (the "Released Parties") from and against any claim or cause of action arising out of participation in the Contest, or receipt or use of any prize, including, but not limited to: (a) unauthorized human intervention in the Contest; (b) technical errors related to computers, servers, providers, or telephone or network lines; (c) printing errors; (d) lost, late, misdirected, incorrect, garbled, or incompletely received entries; (e) errors in the administration of the Contest or the processing of entries; or (f) injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from Entrant's participation in the Contest or acceptance, receipt, use, or misuse of any prize; or travel to any Contest-related events; and (g) any claims based on publicity rights, copyright/trademark infringement, intellectual property rights, defamation or

invasion of privacy and merchandise delivery. Entrant further agrees to release the Released Parties and their designees and assigns from any liability whatsoever, and waive any and all causes of action, for any claims, costs, injuries, losses and damages of any kind arising out of or in connection with the Contest or acceptance, possession, or use of any prize (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees, claims, costs, personal injuries, losses and damages related to personal injuries, death, damage to or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation or portrayal in a false light, whether intentional or unintentional), whether under a theory of contract, tort (including negligence), warranty or other theory. The Host is not responsible if any prize cannot be awarded due to travel cancellations, delays or interruptions due to acts of god, acts of war, natural disasters, weather or acts of terrorism
